It would be great if the dog run could be double gated. When a dog run is double gated, it has an outermost gate that opens into a small, fully-enclosed staging area which then has a gate into the main dog run. The advantage to this is that dogs are less likely to accidentally escape, and it allows dogs to be taken off leash before joining the other dogs - this helps prevent issues caused by leash aggression (some dogs aren't dog friendly when they have a leash on!).
